Obedience & Rally Move-Ups

After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed. This move up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed

the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level of class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit.

Move-up forms may be downloaded from the AKC website (www.akc.org) and/or will also be available at the trial secretary's table.

Please bring a mat or rug to place under your WIRE crates if crating in the show area. All tables and chairs must also have rubber feet to protect the mats.

- NO DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE will be allowed at the Show site, unless entered in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition.
- There is **NO SMOKING** allowed in the building. This will be strictly enforced.

CHINESE AUCTION

A Chinese auction of dog related items and other craft items will be held during the Show. Tickets will be on sale during the Show. Items to be auctioned will be displayed the day of the Show.

SET UP

IMPORTANT: Tarps are required under your grooming area. If you do not have a tarp, a limited number of tarps will be available for you to use.

All grooming must be done in the area specified – the small side of the building – which has access to the show ring, but no visibility to the show ring.

Obedience/Rally – Wire crates & chairs must have rubber feet or be placed on a mat to protect the floor.

Show site will be available for set up beginning at 7:30 a.m. on Friday, May 17.

From Show Site:

Approx. Time & Distance: 16 minutes (8.7 miles)

Proceed West on Manitowoc Road. Turn right on Oneida Street/US Hwy 10 (1 mile). Turn left on US Hwy 10 West to Oshkosh (1.1 miles). Enter ramp following the sign US Hwy 10 to Oshkosh (50 ft). Exit Right following the sign Green Bay/US 41 North (3.8 miles). Exit Right following the sign CR BB/Prospect Avenue (Exit #136) (1.7 miles). Ramp forks, keep Left to CR-BB West (0.2 miles). Exit ramp (Left) at W. Prospect Avenue/CR-BB (100ft.) Turn Right on S. Casaloma Drive (0.6 miles). Turn Left on New Horizons Blvd (1000 ft.). Arrive at Fox Valley Animal Referral Center (300 ft)

“Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.”

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

**Show site is Winnegamie Dog Club Training Center,
7245 Manitowoc Rd., Menasha, WI.
Menasha is located near Appleton, WI.**

From South: I-43 North to West Hwy 10, go left. Follow Hwy 10 approx. 30 miles to Menasha. At stoplights (Oneida St), turn right. At the next set of stop lights (Manitowoc Rd.) turn right. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From South (alternate route): Hwy 41 North to Exit 134 (Hwy 441 & 10), merge right over large bridge. Exit Oneida St., turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From West: Hwy 10 East. Exit Oneida St., turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From North or East: Hwy 41 to Exit 145 (Hwy 441). Exit Oneida St, turn left. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.
