- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies).
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class.

SWEEPSTAKES RULES

- This sweepstakes is open to all Shetland Sheepdogs who, on the day of the Show, will be no less than 6 months old and under 18 months of age.
- No dog which has completed the requirements of an AKC Championship prior to the date of judging may compete in this Sweepstakes, and any Sweepstakes entry fee submitted for such dog shall be refunded upon request of the dog's owner or agent, if such request is received by the Show Secretary no later than the closing date of the Show. For the purpose of those rules, the date of record for the Championship shall be the date of the show at which the dog won its final points.
- All Sweepstakes entries **MUST** also be entered in a regular class. "Sweepstakes" must be indicated on the entry form under "Additional Classes".
- Classes will be as follows: DIVIDED BY SEX
- Puppies, 6 months and under 9 months & 9 months and under 12 months
- Juniors, 12 months and under 18 months
- BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES competition will be held for the winners of the sweepstakes classes. After selection of Best in Sweepstakes, the Runner Up to Best in Sweepstakes shall be selected from the remaining class winners.
- No Prize Money will be offered as the entry for puppy sweepstakes is free.

Obedience & Rally

Bitches in Season: Females in season are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, and the event secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, a full refund will be due the exhibitor.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups): After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer – refer to Chapter 1, Section 16b. Move-up forms may be downloaded from the AKC website (www.akc.org) and/or will also be available at the trial secretary's table.

ENTRY FEES PER SPECIALTY

No online or fax entries accepted – MAIL EARLY

ENTRIES CLOSE – Both Specialties: 6:00 pm, Wednesday, April 30, 2014, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, and/or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All entries **MUST** be complete.

ENTRIES WITHOUT FEES will NOT be accepted. Make all checks payable to the GREEN BAY SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB, INC. Please do not send cash. There will be a \$25 fee for returned checks.

- 1) All fees for **conformation and obedience** include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee on the first entry of a dog and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog. Fees for **rally** include the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee per **entry**.
- 2) Please note that rally is a separate event from the specialty (conformation & obedience); therefore, you must pay the first entry fee (not the additional entry fee) if you also are entering in conformation or obedience.
- 3) Fee for **4-6 Month Beginner Puppy** includes the \$2.00 AKC Recording Fee per entry.

- FAX, E-MAIL, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- NO ENTRY SHALL be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- NO REFUNDS FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for all errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published date of closing.
- CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAMS FOR TIMES OF JUDGING. Judging programs will be used as acknowledgement of entry. SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY EXHIBITOR within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.

Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

- NO DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE will be allowed on the Show site, unless entered in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition
- OBEDIENCE & RALLY CLASS PRIZES: Qualifying scores required for ALL prizes. In designating obedience & rally prizes, "dog" means either sex. In case of tied scores, the prize shall be awarded to the winner of a run-off competition.

Menasha is located near Appleton, WI.

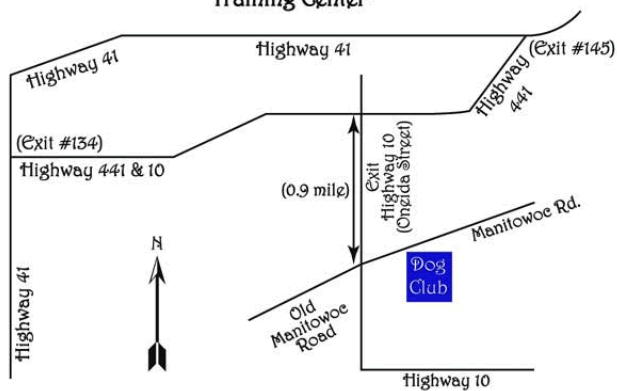

HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
