AKC OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years

- Professional handlers, household members & current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit (see definition above of a professional handler). A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show
- ➤ Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book, in the show catalog and in the judge's book.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner-handler eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series through the breed level competition for the regular show. This includes the class competition & subsequent competition in the breed ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.
- The Owner/Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class & winners competition for the regular show.

ODEDIENCE & RALLY EXHIBITORS - - - PLEASE NOTE:

Bitches in Season: Females in season are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, and the event secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, a full refund will be due the exhibitor.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups): After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer — refer to Chapter 1, Section 16b.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP Novice, Open & Master

Note: AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry in Junior Showmanship competition.

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

The Novice and Open Classes will be divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.

The Junior class is for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the

The Intermediate class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show.

The Senior class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

Special Attraction - Pee Wee Class

Entry: Day of Show (no pre-entry)

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction. The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At a Specialty Club Show the dogs must be of the breed(s) eligible for the event.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

SWEEPSTAKES RULES

- This sweepstakes is open to all Shetland Sheepdogs who, on the day of the Show, will be no less than 6 months old and under 18 months of age.
- No dog which has completed the requirements of an AKC Championship prior to the date of entry closing may compete in this Sweepstakes, and any Sweepstakes entry fee submitted for such dog shall be refunded upon request of the dog's owner or agent, if such request is received by the Show Secretary no later than the closing date of the Show. For the purpose of those rules, the date of record for the Championship shall be the date of the show at which the dog won its final points.
- All Sweepstakes entries MUST also be entered in a regular class. "Sweepstakes" must be indicated on the entry form under "Additional Classes".
- Classes will be as follows: DIVIDED BY SEX Puppies, 6 months and under 9 months & 9 months and under 12 months and Juniors. 12 months and under 18 months
- BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES competition will be held for the winners of the sweepstakes classes. After selection of Best in Sweepstakes, the Runner Up to Best in Sweepstakes shall be selected from the remaining class winners.

DIVISION OF STAKE (Rounded To Nearest Dollar)

Green Bay Shetland Sheepdog Club, Inc. will retain 20% of the total entry fees for expenses. The remainder of the stake shall be divided as follows:

> Best in Sweepstakes - 75% of the remaining stake Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes - 25% of the remaining stake

SHOW REGULATIONS

- FAX, E-MAIL, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- NO ENTRY SHALL be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disgualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- NO REFUNDS FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for all errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published date of closing.
- CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIMES OF JUDGING. Judging program will be used as acknowledgement of entry. SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY EXHIBITOR within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.
- DOGS MAY ARRIVE ANY TIME PRIOR TO SCHEDULED TIME OF JUDGING. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- THE GREEN BAY SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB, INC. assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property. GBSSC further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. PARENTS/GUARDIANS MUST KEEP THEIR CHILDREN UNDER CONTROL ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- DOGS, WHICH, ACCORDING TO THEIR OWNER'S RECORDS, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the shows, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may transfer from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at these shows (Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules).
- OBEDIENCE & RALLY CLASS PRIZES: Qualifying scores required for ALL prizes. In designating obedience & rally prizes, "dog" means either sex. In case of tied scores, the prize shall be awarded to the winner of a run-off competition.
- THE GREEN BAY SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB, INC. asks your cooperation in making use of the exercise pens and in maintaining the cleanliness of the grounds and premises so as not to jeopardize the future use of this show site. ANY EXHIBITOR FAILING TO ADHERE TO THIS POLICY WILL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$50.
- AN ADULT (parent or quardian) MUST sign the entry form for any Junior Handler and/or any dog solely
- Trophies MUST BE PICKED UP the day of the show. NONE will be mailed.
- NO SMOKING Allowed in the Building
- NO DOGS UNDER 4 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PREMITTED IN THE BUILDING. ONLY DOGS THAT ARE AKC ELIGIBLE ARE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS
